## WHAT SHOULD YOU REALLY BE AFRAID OF?

Recently Newsweek magazine published an article with the above title. They pointed out that some of our fears are based on hype and not reality. For instance, there are about 14,000 murders a year in the US but 33,000 suicides. 115 children a year are abducted by strangers but 280 drown in pools. There are 28 shark attacks but 4.5 million dog bites. 33 Americans were killed in 2008 by terrorists but 36,000 died from seasonal flu. 40,000 women die from breast cancer but over 400,000 women die from cardiovascular disease. 50-100 die from allergic reaction to peanuts but over 27,000 die from unintentional poisoning.

All this brought to mind Jesus' teaching in Matthew 10:28, "Do not fear those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul; rather fear him who can destroy both body and soul in hell." Our human reaction is to fight for our physical survival especially in the face of opposition or threats from The Enemy. But Jesus' promise to us is that he will protect and save the very souls of those who follow Him no matter what dangers we face in this world. We must have the eternal perspective that the well-being of our souls is infinitely more important than our physical lives. Our purpose is to prepare our souls for an eternity with God, not to take the easy road in this world. God will be with us in this world, no matter our problems, and will take care of us eternally.
